**How it Works – "It's as easy as 1-2-3"!**

- 1. Plan ahead.** Call 540-443-7111 one day before or if you're a serious planner you can make reservations up to fourteen days in advance. Same day reservations are accepted on a first come, first served basis; advance reservations take priority. Our helpful staff will guide you through the simple reservation process to reserve your trip.
- 2. Meet the vehicle** at the pre-determined pick up location on the day of your trip (a safe location nearby).
- 3. Get on Board.** **Go Anywhere** will then take you to your destination and back, if a return trip is also reserved.

**Reservations:**

Reserve your trip today by calling 540-443-7111, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Reservations can be made up to 14 days in advance.

## How to read the schedule

Read from the top "Blue Loop" down the timetable, connecting to the lower timetable "Gold Loop." Every stop is not listed, but they are listed in numerical order so refer to the map above for additional stops. At the end of a column, return to the top of the next column and begin reading from the top down.

Stop times are estimated; please arrive at least five minutes before the posted departure time. A yellow triangle represents a timecheck; the bus cannot leave these locations early. Several stops have mirror stops on the opposite side of the street; please see map for corresponding stops. For example, stop #11 (Free Clinic) and stop #31 (Community Action) are across the street from each other. While each stop is served every two hours, service to this area is provided once an hour on opposite sides of the street.

Please call us at 540-961-1185 to help you determine which side of the street to stand on, depending on the time of day.

Stops on the map that are blue or gold are served once every two hours, stops that are both blue and gold are served hourly.

**Courtesy Stops:** Riders can request additional stops, either on or off the existing route. When boarding, please ask the operator to make a courtesy stop and he or she will ask BT for approval. Requests are approved on a first come, first served basis. Example: If the route is on the Gold Loop and a passenger needs to go to The Bluffs (Stop 14), just ask the operator. He or she can detour off route slightly to get you a little closer to your destination.

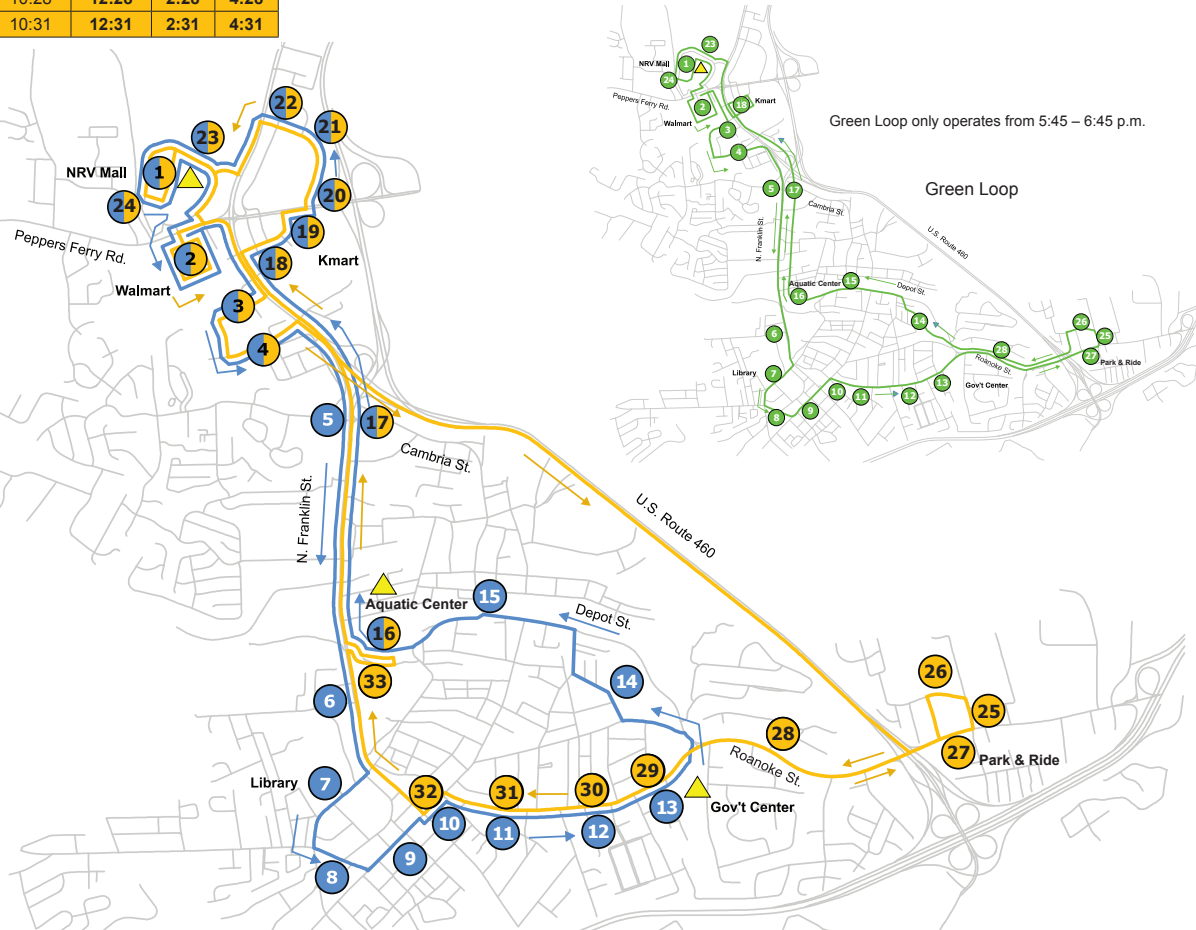

## General Information

*Amenities – it's the little comforts that make the trip worthwhile!*

- Parcel Bins** – As an added bonus, *The Explorer* and *Go Anywhere* buses are equipped with parcel bins above the seats to store your packages.
- Bike Racks** – Every bus in our fleet has a bike rack and can hold up to two bikes at a time! Be sure to ask your operator for assistance, if needed.
- Child Seats** – Our smaller buses, used on *The Explorer* and *Go Anywhere* have child seats to keep your precious cargo safe.
- Reading Lights** – Our smaller buses, used on *The Explorer* and *Go Anywhere* have reading lights above all seating.

## Lost and Found

Any item left on the bus will remain there until the end of the day. If you remember the bus number, you can get on that bus and check with the Operator; unclaimed items will be turned in to BT at the end of the day. ## What you need to know!

- The Explorer** route serves Christiansburg's downtown central business district, surrounding neighborhoods, the NRV Mall area, Spradlin Farms and the Park & Ride.
- The Go Anywhere** service requires advance reservations and provides trips from any place in Christiansburg to any destination within Christiansburg town limits. To reserve a trip on the *Go Anywhere* service call 540-443-7111, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

## Connections

### Travel to the NRV Mall area:

Connect to the NRV Mall area by using the *Go Anywhere* service or catching *The Explorer* route at any designated BT stop. Schedule a trip on the *Go Anywhere* service by calling 540-443-7111, Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

### Travel between Christiansburg and Blacksburg:

To Christiansburg: Take the **Two Town Trolley** from Blacksburg to the NRV Mall and connect to either *The Explorer* or *Go Anywhere* (must call ahead to schedule a trip on the *Go Anywhere* service). To Blacksburg: Take either *The Explorer* or *Go Anywhere* to the NRV Mall and catch the **Two Town Trolley** to Blacksburg.

### Travel between Christiansburg and Roanoke, Lynchburg and beyond:

Blacksburg Transit shares some bus stops with the Smart Way and Megabus routes.

Connect to Roanoke and Lynchburg (Amtrak) via the Smart Way: Take *The Explorer* or *Go Anywhere* to the Knart stop (Explorer stop # 18) or the Park & Ride stop (Explorer stop # 27) and catch the Smart Way bus. For information on the Smart Way schedule, please visit [www.smartwaybus.com](http://www.smartwaybus.com) or call 1-800-388-7005.

Connect to Knoxville, Washington, D.C. and beyond: Take *The Explorer* or *Go Anywhere* to the Park & Ride (stop #27) and catch the Megabus; route information can be found at [www.megabus.com](http://www.megabus.com).
